



**COVID-19 Behaviour Policy**  
**An Addendum to the current**  
**School Behaviour Policy (2020-21)**

*This Policy is an addition to the school Behaviour Policy(2020-21) and therefore all procedures and processes outlined in these policies are still in place.*  
This revised Behaviour Policy reflects the return of all children from September 2020.

## Introduction

The aim of this policy is to continue to promote good standards of behaviour within our school, but in light of the need for children to behave differently when they return to school during a period of change and at a time where staff and children's safety is our main priority, this is more important than ever. This addendum to our current Behaviour Policy (2020-21) will be communicated to pupils, parents and staff.

## Behaviour expectations for children

1. Altered routines for arrival or departure  
Children must only enter and exit the school gates assigned to their group on the staggered time given.
2. Hygiene  
Children should wash and sanitise their hands on request, and as a minimum at the following times; on entry, before food, after food, after changing resource, before playtime, after playtime, before exiting the school.
3. Respiratory Hygiene  
Children should adhere to the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' routine when sneezing, blowing nose and coughing, tissues should be at their disposal and thrown into a lidded pedal bin. Children should be encouraged to avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands. Under no circumstances should children be coughing or spitting at any other person.
4. Social Distancing  
Children should avoid moving around school as much as possible and should follow the instructions from their adults (for example, following the one-way systems, avoiding areas out of bounds and any queuing). Children must only socialise with children within their 'bubble' year group.
5. Symptoms of coronavirus  
Children should be reminded/encouraged to tell an adult if they are experiencing any common symptoms of COVID-19 immediately.
6. Sharing any equipment  
Children should NOT share any of their personal equipment and resources, food items or drinking bottles.
7. Break & lunch times  
Children must follow the instructions from their adults about designated spaces on the playground and field. Children will not be allowed to mix with any other 'bubble' groups during these times. Children are to only use their designated 'bubble' group equipment.
8. Use of toilets  
Children will be asked to use their designated toilet block only (upper and lower school).

**The above procedures will be enforced and work alongside the schools 'The Rights Behaviour Flow Chart'.**

- \* Theft
- \* Physical violence towards a child or adult
- \* Leaving class without permission
- \* Persistent refusal to obey rules
- \* Threatening to cough or spit at another child.
- \* Socialising with children not within their year group 'bubble'
