Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to inform you that a child in Year 6 has tested positive for Covid-19. Having sought advice from the Department for Education, we have been informed that no further action is required. As a result of the child self-isolating due to other family members displaying symptoms, the child has not been attending school. Symptoms only developed later in the isolation period and therefore the child was not in school at the time when they would have been in the contagious period (two days prior to symptoms developing or two days prior to a positive test result).

I wanted to be open and transparent with you all about the situation and having sought official advice reassure you that as a school, we do not need to do anything further than our current measures we have in place. Therefore, all Year 6 pupils and staff are able to continue attending school.

Please can I take this opportunity to remind you that should your child, or anyone in the household, develop symptoms, it is important that you notify the school immediately and your child and family self-isolate.
