Dear Parents / Carers,

You may be aware that the UK Chief Medical Officers have released a statement today regarding changes that are to be made to the Covid-19 isolation period from 14 days to 10 days. This change will apply in England from 00:01am on Monday 14th December. **As a result, the children in the Year 3 bubble groups who have been required to self-isolate due to being in close contact with a confirmed positive Covid-19 case will be able to return to school on Monday 14th December as they will have completed 10 days of self-isolation.** Please can I remind the parents of these pupils that their child will need to continue to self-isolate over this weekend but the isolation period will end on Monday allowing them to return to school on this day. Please remember that your child cannot return to school on Monday if they are displaying any Covid-19 symptoms and will need to continue to self-isolate at home with the rest of the household.

On Monday 14th December, the changes to the isolation period for contacts will apply to all those who are currently self-isolating including those who commenced self-isolation before Monday. Anyone who tests positive should continue to self-isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or 10 days from the point of taking a positive test if asymptomatic.

We look forward to welcoming the Year 3 children back to school on Monday.
