Year 5 Isle of Wight Residential Visit: Monday 16th – Friday 20th May 2022

We are very excited to be able to give you details of our residential visit to the Isle of Wight next year. It will be our fourteenth visit to the island and we are excited to be staying at Winchester House YMCA in Shanklin. Winchester House is located on the clifftop between the seaside towns of Shanklin and Sundown. Overlooking Hope Bay, it provides the perfect setting for school and group accommodation, and a great place to access all island locations. During the visit we will visit:

- Carisbrooke Castle
- Robin Hill Country Park
- Tack-t-Isle Adventures water sports
- Sandown beach day out

The total cost of this visit is **£263.00** per child, which covers the cost of travel, full board, 4 night's accommodation, all activities and insurance. We have scheduled the following contribution plan:

This is always a very popular visit and, as we anticipate a high demand, we strongly advise that you book your child's place as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

We are extremely excited about the prospect of re-commencing our residential visits programme, and please be reassured, that during the current situation, we are constantly updating our procedures and practises to ensure fully safe and successful visit experiences for our children.
