**PE Kit Expectations**

Children must **come to school** in the correct Two Mile Ash PE kit on the days they have PE and any sporting clubs/events. It is an expectation that all Two Mile Ash children will wear the **approved school PE kit**. Our children take great pride in their school and this is always reflected in the way they dress for school and PE lessons.




All items of **jewellery** should be removed or earrings taped up for PE; tape should be provided by the child. Religious jewellery is accepted however, health and safety should be considered by parents prior to the child wearing it. If a child has forgotten their kit, spare kit will be provided from the changing rooms and parents will be contacted and reminded of PE kit expectations.

The school PE kit provider is **Maisies Superstore**, Wolverton, Milton Keynes. Please discuss any problems regarding difficulties providing uniform with your child’s class teacher or Mr. Saville.



Pupils at Two Mile Ash School take part in regular PE lessons that are held both indoors and outdoors. Pupils need to dress and be prepared for all weathers, with extra warm clothing in the winter months acceptable.
