We are currently planning various activities and celebration opportunities and we look forward to sharing this with you at a later date.

We are very excited to share our Year 6 residential '**Bushcraft experience**'

There's a wide range of outdoor activities, available at Boughton (Northamptonshire), all designed to enhance social and personal development, whilst having fun and learning new skills.

The experience creates a bespoke programme to suit all ages and abilities, keeping them busy from the moment they arrive. Some of their favourites on offer are: Fire Lighting, Shelter Building, Camouflage and Concealment, Target Sports, Scenario SOS and many more!

Situated in the heart of the woodlands, each camp comprises of a large yurt and cosy campfire for mealtimes and talks, its own field kitchen, and safari-style bell tents to sleep in. There's also single-sex porta-loos.

Bushcraft Camps are run by a team of experienced instructors, who will remain with the group and take care of the activities, mealtimes and pastoral care (along with TMA staff) of students for the entirety of their stay.
