As **Readers** we will focus on varying the text types we are reading whilst also practicing the skills we have developed so far this year in inference, summarising and retrieval. We will also work on our expression and intonation through reading aloud.

As **Writers** we shall be looking at developing our understanding of writing stories. We will learn that to write a story, you must be skilful at interweaving dialogue, description and action into one, easy to read, engaging piece of work.

As **Historians** we learn about the changes our country has gone through in the years after World War II. We learn about the changes that Great Britain has experienced that include political, social, economic, technological and cultural alterations. Of these changes, we consider which ones have had the most impact on our lives today.

As **Geographers** we revise our understanding of the location and make-up of the British Isles. We consider where our own families and relatives originate from and compare their localities to our own.

As **Design Technologists** we will be working on a 'Network Rail' project to create working mechanisms.

As **Artists** we will learning about Pop art and the leaders in this art movement. These include Yayoi Kusama, Roy Lichtenstein, Andy Warhol and David Hockney. We will use technology to produce original artwork in a pop art style focusing on reprographic techniques to replicate pieces after editing features including tone, colour and texture.
