Rehearsal with the Bradwell Silver Band

The week before the concert, we will hold our Harmonize rehearsal on <u>Tuesday 28th November</u> in the hall at Two Mile Ash School from 7:00pm until 9:00pm. This is really important, as it is our only opportunity to rehearse with the band before the concert. Children must be collected promptly at 9:00pm from the Hall. We will hold our usual Wednesday rehearsal on 29th November for a final run-through of everything before the concert the following week.

Rehearsal on the day

On the evening of Wednesday 6th December, all children need to be dropped off at Shenley Brook End School Theatre at 5:00pm. They need to come dressed ready for the concert, and should have a named water bottle with them. We will rehearse for the concert, then get the children ready to perform.

Tickets

Please come along to support your child, they love to spot a familiar face in the auditorium and it gives them such a boost of pride! Tickets are priced at £3, and will be available on ParentPay very soon. Purchased tickets will be given out to the children during the week of the concert. Please note that we are not limiting tickets, but we do have a maximum capacity, please order tickets promptly when they become available.

Clothing for the concert

The children need to wear dark trousers/skirts (school clothing is fine), dark shoes, and a either a plain black T-shirt or a Harmonize T-shirt. Please bear in mind that it becomes very warm under stage lights, so the children do not need to wear layers. If they do not have a black Harmonize t-shirt, they must wear a plain black t-shirt instead. Harmonize logo t-shirts are available to order from Maisies should you wish to purchase one, but please do this in plenty of time before the concert so that your order can be fulfilled. We do not sell Harmonize t-shirts through school.

Please note that the auditorium will not be open to audience members until approximately 7:10pm-7:15pm, and you will need to bring your tickets with you. If you have any special seating requirements, please email Harmonize@tma.bucks.sch.uk when you purchase your ticket.
