Visit to Milton Keynes Library

To help to further children's enjoyment of reading we have organised a short trip to visit Central Milton Keynes library.

During our visit to the library, the children will have time to explore the children's area and be able to select some books to enjoy whilst they are there. Also, a story teller from the library will read a story to everyone to really engage the children in all that the library can offer.

We hope this trip will help to continue our children to read for pleasure and encourage them to return to the library. To access all the services the library provides, all you need is a library card. This year, we are giving the children the opportunity to use the library services of borrowing books whilst we are on the trip. If your child already has their own library card then they may bring this along on the day of the trip to borrow books. If your child does not already have their own library card, you can fill in this application form to join the library service. If your child does borrow any books during the trip, the returning of the books will be the responsibility of you and your child.

The children will leave school at approx. 1:30pm and return around 3:00pm, in time for normal end of day procedures. They will be transported to and from the library by our school mini- buses.
