**Year 6 SATs Evening – Wednesday, 29<sup>th</sup> November – 5:30-7:00pm**

We would like to invite you to attend the forthcoming SATs Information Evening which aims to:

- explain how the SATs are administered in our school
- answer any questions or concerns you may have about your child accessing these tests
- give you a greater insight into the tests and ways in which you can help your child to succeed.

The format for the evening will start with an introduction in the hall for all parents. This will begin at **5.30pm** and last for approximately 10mins. However, should you wish to peruse the books available from CGP Revision, you will be able to do this from **5:00pm** in the hall and take away an order form to complete.

Following this, and the introduction, you are invited to stay and spend time in our teacher lead workshops. Each session will last for approximately 20 minutes and will focus on maths, grammar and reading. The sessions will run simultaneously and be repeated in each time slot.

**Session 1: 5.50-6:10pm**– Maths, SPAG, Reading

**Session 2: 6:15- 6:35pm**– Maths, SPAG, Reading

**Session 3: 6:40-7.00pm** – Maths, SPAG, Reading

**Please note that places will only be available to those parents who book online, the deadline for which is Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> November. Unfortunately, due to anticipated interest and numbers, we ask that children do not attend this evening and that only one parent attends each session. Each workshop can accommodate a maximum of 34 participants. Sessions can be booked under your child's name; a maximum of 3 sessions can be booked per child, ONE parent attending each. Booking period is LIVE from Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> November.**
