Year 4 Curriculum

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
French:

The children will build on their previous knowledge of food and clothes to learn shopping vocabulary. They will also learn about animals, countries and continents; including where in the world French is spoken. Children will also continue to build on their French Phonics knowledge.



Science: During the spring term, we will be studying animals including humans. This will include looking at types of teeth and understanding their functions. We will also investigate the functions of the digestive system and be able to identify where these are. We will also look at food chains and

We will be developing our coding skill, utilising code to duplicate and synchronise commands and actions within a programme. We will then use our understanding to remix and reuse code to create new content




This term the children will continue their learning on ocarina and recorder. They will be continuing to read formal written music notation alongside symbols. We will also be composing simple patterns using the notes B and
