



The Safety Centre's education team are running parent and carer online safety workshops to help adults support their children safely use and enjoy the online world. Sessions cost £5 and last for 45 minutes. Our first session is this Friday lunchtime on Zoom between 12.30-1.15pm (19.01.24) and we have a face-to-face evening session at the Safety Centre in Kiln Farm on (25.01.24). We plan to run additional sessions later in the year too.

There's been a lot of news coverage recently about the dangers young people face when they're gaming, using the internet and apps and as a safety education charity we're here to support families navigate this complex topic. Sessions will cover the dangers young people can face on apps and games, oversharing, live streaming, grooming, cyberbullying, sexting, what parents can do to help including setting parental controls, monitoring apps and conversations and family agreements. We'll also share online resources for family agreements and a wider range of online tools to help start family conversations.
