Year 5 Isle of Wight Residential Visit: Tuesday 14th – Friday 17th May 2024

Please find below details for your child's year group residential for the 2023-2024 academic year. This visit represents one part of our learning outside the classroom extended programme at Two Mile Ash.

This progressive programme features many in-school events, day visits and residential overnight visits, all designed and planned to support our curriculum and offer a full range of experiences for our children.

In order for you to see how our residential programme fits in, and to help with future budgeting, we have outlined below each visit and the cost for next academic year:

Year 3: An overnight stay at TMA school with on-site activities TBC (Spring Term)

Year 4: A 2-night stay at Whitemoor Lakes Outdoor Activity Centre £207.50 (Spring Term)

Year 5: A 3-night stay on The Isle of Wight with activity days £298.50 (Summer Term)

Year 6: A 2-night stay in Bournemouth with visits to local attractions £162.00 (Summer Term)

Year 5/6: 6-night Ski trip in the European Alps with full evening activities £1046.25 (Spring Term)

We are very proud of the provision we have in place and always strive to offer the best experience and value possible. Please do not hesitate to contact the school with any questions you may have.

We are very excited to be able to give you details of our residential visit to the Isle of Wight next year. It will be our fifteenth visit to the island, and we are excited to be staying at Winchester House YMCA in Shanklin. Winchester House is located on the clifftop between the seaside towns of Shanklin and Sandown. Overlooking Hope Bay, it provides the perfect setting for school and group accommodation, and a great place to access all island locations.

During the visit we will visit:

- Robin Hill Country Park
- Tack-Isle Adventures water sports
- Sandown beach day out
- Donkey Sanctuary

The total cost of this visit is **£298.50** per child, which covers the cost of travel, full board, 3 night's accommodation, all activities and insurance. We have scheduled the following contribution plan:

All our residential visits will be available on ParentPay as of Friday 21st July 2023. If you would like to secure a place for your child, please complete the attached consent slip along with the non-refundable deposit paid on the ParentPay portal of £58.50 (this is a non-refundable school holding deposit paid to the visit provider).

If insufficient funds are not received, it may result in the cancellation of the visit. In addition, there are limited spaces, therefore places will be based on a first come, first served policy. This is always a very popular visit and, as we anticipate a high demand, we strongly advise that you book your child's place as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.
