

Year 3 Safari MK Sleepover Friday 12th July 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to share with you the exciting news of an overnight 'sleepover' opportunity that we would like to offer to our Year 3 pupils.

At Two Mile Ash School we are extremely proud of the learning outside the classroom extended programme we offer to all of our children throughout the 4 years they are with us. This includes a one night 'sleep over' in Year 3 to multi night residentials in upper school; visiting locations such as Bournemouth and the Isle of Wight. Each year, we re-evaluate our offer to ensure we are providing the best experiences for our children and at an affordable budget for our families.

This year, we have secured a new overnight experience for our year 3 pupils at Safari MK, located in Kiln Farm, Milton Keynes. This is a great opportunity for us and the children to celebrate a fantastic first year at Two Mile Ash School in a fun and exciting way with all of your child's friends.

On Friday 12th July, we have booked the popular soft play venue for sole use for TMA Year 3 children from 6:15pm. Once the children have been dropped off at Safari MK, they will have free play time in the soft play in the evening. When it is time to begin calming down before bed, the children will have a hot milk drink and a biscuit. They will then get ready for their sleepover at Safari MK. In the morning, the children will be provide with a breakfast of toast and cereals before being collected by yourselves at approx. 8:00am. Further details regarding the confirmed timings and a kit list will be sent closer to the date of the trip.

This is an ideal trip for our Year 3's as we are aware many children haven't spent a night away from home before. Members of the Year 3 team and other members of the Two Mile Ash School staff will be with the children at all times during the sleep over.

The total cost of this visit is £17 per child which covers all the indoor soft play, juice throughout the stay, milk and biscuit before bed and breakfast.

The deadline for payments is Friday 10th May. The bookings will go live through our new system, My Child At School, during the week commencing 15th April. We will send a communication when the bookings are going to be live and instructions on how to book. We are wanting to give you as much notice as possible so that if you're interested in securing your child a place, you have time to plan accordingly.

There are limited spaces for this sleepover, therefore places will be based on a first come, first served policy. We anticipate a high demand so we strongly advise that you book your child's place as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. Furthermore, if insufficient funds are received, it may result in the cancellation of the visit.
