

Dear parents and carers of Harmonize children,

I am emailing with a few important changes to the coming weeks, some dates for your diaries.

As you know, next Wednesday is our wonderful STEM Fayre. In order for all children (and staff!) to be involved, Harmonize will not take place on Wednesday 24th April as previously communicated. Instead, we will start back on Wednesday 1st May with one of our famous all-request sessions.

During the week of Monday 13th May, our Year 6 children will be concentrating on their SATs and many of our Year 5s will be visiting the Isle of Wight on their residential. There will therefore be no Harmonize on Wednesday 15th May.

We are excited that Harmonize TMA will be performing at the MK Community Choirs Festival once again this year. As in previous years, the festival will be held in Campbell Park Amphitheatre, and is taking place on Saturday 1st June. We hope lots of our Harmonize singers will be able to represent the school despite this date falling in half term, more details will come home with your child shortly. We are also hoping to perform for you at another TMA event in the second half of this term, so watch out for that.

If your child is a current member of Harmonize and wants to participate in Young Voices in January 2025, we will be asking you to book their place before the end of this academic year. I know January next year seems a long way off, but there is a lot of organisation already happening behind the scenes. I hope that by allowing more time, we take the pressure off our Harmonize families as much as we can, and we avoid children missing out. Details about Young Voices 2025 will come home in June.
