



Year 3 Curriculum Overview



History:

During the summer term, we are excited to learn all about the ancient civilisation of 'The Egyptians'. We will use of historical researcher skills to use different sources, such as hieroglyphics, to find out about the Gods, the Pyramids and mummification. We will also look at the key individual of Tutankhamun, the boy pharaoh.

Science:

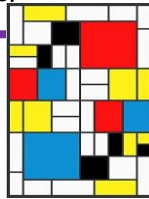
During the summer term, we will be looking at forces and magnets, as well as the human body and healthy eating. We will investigate the push and pull forces and look at properties of magnets and magnetic materials. Later on, we will discuss the elements of a healthy meal and how the human body is structured.

Geography:

During the summer term, we will be looking at climate change and the impact on the world currently. We will be conducting field work looking at the impact we have on our local area and how we can be more sustainable.

Art:

In art, we will be looking at the works of Mondrian and using block colours and line to create our own master pieces.



Music:

This term, we will be continuing to develop our woodwind skills through the ocarina, in preparation for learning the recorder next year. We will also begin to look at formal written music alongside the informal method they we have been using throughout Year 3 so far, as well as focusing on note length and tone.



PE:

During the summer term, we will start looking at all the different types of discipline within athletics including a variety of track and field events. We will learn to sprint a distance of up to 60 metres and we will practise conserving energy in order to sustain performance in longer running events.

We will then start to look at summer team sports like cricket, rounders and tennis. We will aim to develop their hand-eye co-ordination and work as a team to achieve results. We will develop throwing and catching techniques and gradually introduce games and match play.

French:

This term we will start by learning days of the week and continuing numbers to 31. This will lead into learning about months of the year and being able to say when our birthdays are. Lastly, we will learn about items in the classroom and in your pencil case.

DT:

In DT, we will using our needlework skills and creating a sewing piece, focusing on different basic stitches to create an overall pleasing design.

RE:

In RE we will continue to develop our understanding of Christianity. We will look at moral dilemmas and how Christian's solve them. We will continue to learn more about who Jesus was and what he said, taking into account other points of view as well as including our own opinions.



Computing:

During the summer term, we will learn how information in a database is organised and interrogated. Following a theme of an imaginary travel website, we will use a prepared database to find information about holidays and add records using information found online.



PSHE:

We will be talking and learning about how we have changed since we were born. We will discuss things we can do now that we couldn't when we were smaller and learning that not all families are the same but all families give us support in different ways.
